glue stick or school glue*

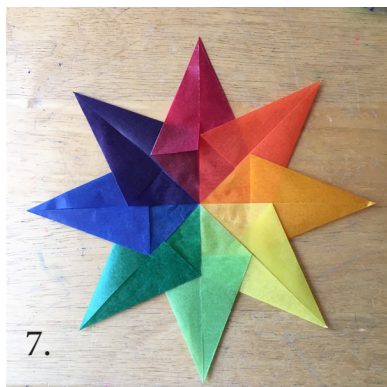
# Basic Window Star



Step 1: Begin with a squares of kite paper. Step 2: Fold one sheet over diagonal to make a triangle. Step 3: Fold one corner to the center line.



Step 4: fold the opposite corner to the center line. Step 5: Repeat the whole process with seven more pieces of paper. Now you should have 8 diamonds. Step 6: Using a glue stick or school glue, stick each piece together, making sure you glue with the folded side facing up. Glue only the parts of the paper that are touching one another. The skinny part of the kite should be at the top, and the wider part at the bottom where you are gluing.



Step 7: When the star is glued together, turn it round so the folds are at the back. It's now ready to be attached to a window, using a dab of glue in the center and at each tip or piece of tape.
